The New Mexico Regional Competition is an unique opportunity for middle school children to combine skills in engineering, environmental science, and art to create a vision for the future. Exercising your imagination and sharing your ideas are not only fun but essential for ensuring sustainable growth for our communities. Students work as a team with an educator and engineer mentor to plan cities using SimCityTM software: research and write solutions to an engineering program.

Vision: New Mexico Regional Competition is established to promote positive learnings through teamwork, creative writing, computer modeling, resource planning, and art for middle school children.

Regional Competition Logistics:

- Students 6th through 8th grades are all eligible to participate.
- Each participating organization must register online.
- There are no limits on the number of teams within each organization.
- Each team must have at least three members.
- It is absolutely free to all participating schools, plus teachers who host a team receive \$100 stipend.
