Beatrice Dubois has always been a strong advocate for LANL employee giving programs. A perennial helper, she didn't realize that she might someday need help herself.

On February 21, 2011, a devastating fire broke out at Bea's home. She and her granddaughter were injured, and the fire completely destroyed their home, belongings, and vehicles. Bea's coworkers responded quickly and called on local nonprofit organizations to help. Self Help, Inc., American Red Cross, and Trinity on the Hill Episcopal Church and Thrift Store responded by providing clothing, housing, and other assistance to Bea and her family.
